The children played some bug games, they built a big spider web and then the spider chased all the little flies around the web trying to catch them.



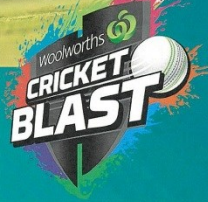

Girls Group students have been making socks to sell at our NAIDOC.

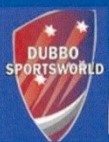

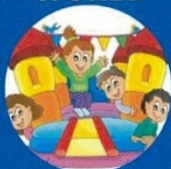
